PRIMARY TEXT:

Acts 4, Hebrews 4

OBSERVATION AND APPLICATIONS

 Hebrews 4:12 says the Word of God is "living and active." What does that mean to you?
The verse also says God's Word judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. How does that challenge or encourage you?
• In Acts 4:13, the religious leaders were amazed because Peter and John were "unschooled" but had clearly been with Jesus. What does that tell us about the source of their boldness?
How do these two verses—Hebrews 4:12 and Acts 4:13—work together to show the power of God's Word and the presence of Jesus?



S.O.A.P. METHOD

Use this tool to study God's Word

SCRIPTURE Write which passage of scripture you are reading.
OBSERVATION What is this text saying? What is the context? How does it fit with the verses before and after
it? Are there any commands or instructions?
APPLICATION How can you apply this verse to your life? What does this mean today? What is God saying to you?
PRAYER Respond to the passage in prayer. Ask God to help you apply this truth to your life and spend some time listening to what He may be telling you.
