# **OBSERVATION AND APPLICATIONS**

How do the women in Matthew 28 respond when they encounter the empty tomb and the risen Jesus?
Isaiah 53 describes the Messiah as "a man of suffering." Why is it
important that Jesus suffered before rising from the grave?
• Isaiah 53:5 says, "By His wounds we are healed." What does healing through Christ's wounds mean to you personally?
• In Matthew 28:10, Jesus says, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell" What does this teach us about our role as followers of the Risen King?



# S.O.A.P. METHOD

Use this tool to study God's Word

SCRIPTURE Write which passage of scripture you are reading.
OBSERVATION What is this text saying? What is the context? How does it fit with the verses before and after
it? Are there any commands or instructions?
APPLICATION  How can you apply this verse to your life? What does this mean today? What is God saying to you?
PRAYER  Respond to the passage in prayer. Ask God to help you apply this truth to your life and spend some time listening to what He may be telling you.
