OBSERVATION AND APPLICATIONS

- Read Acts 9:36.
 - How would people describe you today?
 - How does this compare to the legacy you would like to leave?

- Read Matthew 5:14-16.
 - How can you “let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven?”
 - What are practical steps you can take to be a light of the world? What areas of your life do you need to ask the Lord to grow you?

- Read Acts 9:40.
 - How did Peter know what to do in this situation?

- Read Mark 5:35-43.
 - Why do you think Jesus “put them all out” in Mark 5:40 and Peter “sent them all out” in Acts 9:40? (Read Matthew 17:20-21.)
