It has been said, "We will do anything short of sin to see one more person transformed from death to eternal life through the power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ." Our worship environment is dynamic and contemporary, but most importantly, it is passionate. We value creativity and the participation of all age groups in worship. House Church is our method for engaging in faith-based community, providing a weekly gathering space where anyone can join at any time to share a meal, pray, and dig deeper into scripture together. House Churches have been instrumental in helping our church family transition from a "come and see" to a "go and be" mindset. These groups have helped us

extend our reach into various areas and neighborhoods in the communities we serve. We desire to expand our reach by carefully and strategically **adding new campuses** as God leads. We strive to create inviting spaces where people far from God feel welcomed and valued so that they might meet Jesus and begin their faith journey.

MOVEMENT LEADER

The Lead Pastor will be the chief steward of our decisions, and we will respect, support, and share the weight of difficult decisions with him.

We want a Lead Pastor who serves by seeking new territory to claim for God and the Church. We want someone who will seek to find new methods, means, and innovations that are a good fit and equip us to serve more effectively. We have grown by adapting and implementing approaches that most effectively reach those who are far from God and believe that method is beneficial for future growth.

LEAD TEACHING PASTOR

The Lead Pastor will be responsible for casting vision in planning message series and developing methods to guide the congregation in studying and applying God's word to their lives. While the Lead Pastor will be the primary teaching pastor, we value utilizing multiple voices to teach our congregation. The Lead Pastor will plan, guide, mentor, and coach other teachers.

DEVELOPER OF OTHERS

The Lead Pastor will be responsible for serving and developing other leaders by helping them mature in their calling, gifts, and ministry areas to serve our church family and the Kingdom. In our multisite approach, we value the development of many leaders at all levels to expand our reach and impact eternity.
